The Titanic

On April 10, the RMS Titanic, one of the largest and most luxurious ocean liners ever built, departed Southampton, England, on its maiden voyage across the Atlantic Ocean.

At 2:20 a.m. on April 15, 1912, the British ocean liner Titanic sinks into the North Atlantic Ocean about 400 miles south of Newfoundland, Canada. The massive ship, which carried 2,200 passengers and crew, had struck an iceberg two and half hours before.

The Titanic was considered unsinkable. It also has become immortalized inspiring documentaries, television dramas and Hollywood blockbusters.

Solar Eclipse

What happens during a total solar eclipse? The moon will line up perfectly between the Earth and the sun, blotting out the sunlight. On April 8th, 2024 it will slice a diagonal line from the southwest to the northeast across North America, briefly plunging communities along the track into darkness.

How long is the totality of an eclipse? Totality may only last a few minutes, depending on your location. If you're in the path of totality, expect it to last about 4 minutes.

1860 Pony Express - A mail delivery service powered by hardy riders on fast horses began between Missouri and California, USA. Messages could now be sent between the east and west coasts in just 10 days **1932 Vitamin C** - A lemony cure US scientist Charles Glen King identified vitamin C in lemon juice. He proved that this vitamin, found in many fruits and vegetables, could cure scurvy – a fatal disease caused by a lack of vitamin C.

1935 Dust storm - The day turned dark when an enormous cloud of sand and dust blew into the USA's drought-stricken Southern Plains, giving the area its famous name "The Dust Bowl"

1938 Here comes Superman! Comic book legend Superman appeared for the first time in Action Comics #1. Created by US writer and artist duo Jerry Siegel and Joe Shuster, Superman was the first comic book hero to have superpowers
