On July 4, 1884, France presented the United States with an incredible birthday gift: the Statue of Liberty! Without its pedestal, it's as tall as a 15-story building. First American Flag

The first official American flag was adopted on June 14, 1777, when the Second Continental Congress passed the Flag Act of 1777. This resolution declared the new nation's flag would consist of 13 alternating red and white stripes and 13 white stars on a blue field, representing a "new constellation".
